NOTICE

Sub: DHFWS, BOME - Admission of CENTAC sponsored students in P.G. Medical/Dental courses in their allotted seats by the Deemed to be Universities Medical/Dental Colleges as per the interim direction of Hon'ble High Court, Chennai - Reg.

Attention is invited to the Notices cited under reference (1), wherein the Private Medical College including Deemed to be Universities functioning in the U.T. of Puducherry were directed to admit the candidates as per the allotment made by the CENTAC under Government Quota/Management Quota without fail.

2. Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P(Civil) No. 267/2017 in the matter of *Dar-Us-Slam Educational Trust Vs. Medical Council of India*, had ruled that students have to deposit their Demand Draft towards the payment of tuition fees with counseling authorities and the same will be forwarded to the respective medical college immediately, in order to avoid refusal of admission to the students reporting to respective Colleges. Therefore, such of those students who remitted their Demand Drafts towards tuition fees to the counselling authorities viz., CENTAC, are deemed to have been admitted to the allotted seats in the respective Medical College. The Colleges have however been refusing the Demand Drafts submitted by the counseling authority and admitting other students against the students sponsored by CENTAC, which is contrary to law and orders passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court.

3. Pursuant to the directions contained in the interim order of Hon'ble High Court of Madras in WP No.14232 of 2107 cited under reference(2) and in continuation of the notices cited under reference above, the management of the Deemed to be Universities are directed to admit the students who were provisionally allotted seats under common counselling by the CENTAC authorities and had remitted their fee to the CENTAC authorities against the vacancy for which they were selected in the order of the merit under Puducherry State Merit and All India Merit towards State Government Quota and All India Quota respectively. The final allotment list communicated as on 31.5.2017, copy of which has been communicated to Medical Council of India is the valid list and binding on the Colleges / Institutions concerned.

4. Hence, in continuation to the Notices cited under reference and as per the directions contained in the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Chennai, cited under reference(2), the management of the Deemed to be Universities are therefore directed to implement the

directions scrupulously by admitting the students sponsored by CENTAC under Government/Management Quota in their respective allotted seats immediately. Any failure on the part of the deemed universities in admitting the students already allotted by the CENTAC by accepting the demand draft for Rs.10.00 lakhs would be construed as contempt of court leading to further legal proceedings against the college.

5. Sequel to admitting the provisionally selected students in compliance of the orders of Hon'ble High Court of Madras, the management of the Deemed to be Universities are requested to furnish the updated list of candidates admitted in their College under Government/Management Quota without fail by 12.00 Noon on 19-06-2017 for submitting the same to the Hon'ble High Court, Chennai.

6. Notice to be taken that the Deemed to be Universities shall not admit any other candidates against the candidates other than, such of those allotted by CENTAC under common counselling in terms of Section 9A of Post Graduate Medical Education Regulation to both Government/Management Quota. Admissions, if any, made will be in contravention of PG Medical Education Regulation / instructions of GOI / orders of Supreme Court and shall be void abinitio attracting such action as may be deemed appropriate by the authorities concerned.
