Sub: DHFWS, BOME – Seat sharing between non-Governmental Medical Colleges and State Government in case of PG admissions - Reg.

The Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare vide their letter cited under reference, has stated that as per the provisions contained in Sub-Clause VI of Clause 9 of the Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000,

***“In non-Governmental medical colleges/institutions, 50% (fifty percent) of the total seats shall be filled by State Government or the Authority appointed by them and the remaining 50% (Fifty percent) of the seats shall be filled by the concerned medical colleges/institutions on the basis of the merit list prepared as per the marks obtained in National Eligibility-cum Entrance Test”***

The Ministry has therefore directed to ensure that admissions to all PG medical courses in non-Governmental medical colleges are done on the basis of the aforesaid provision by applying their earlier directions communicated in their letter second referred above with regard to common counseling.

2. You are therefore directed to reserve 50% of seats in each discipline of the Post Graduate courses offered in your institution for filling up by the Government of Puducherry, through a designated authority, as directed by Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
3. It is also directed that, for filling up the remaining 50% of the seats in PG courses under management quota, the Government of Puducherry will be conducting a common counseling for all private medical/dental colleges including colleges under Deemed Universities as has been directed by the Government of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
4. The Government of Puducherry, has entrusted the work mentioned at paras (2) & (3) to CENTAC and therefore the manner, methodology by which admission/common counseling is done can be obtained from the O/o of the CENTAC for PG Admission in Medical/Dental Colleges, Pondicherry Engineering College (Campus), Puducherry.
5. You are therefore directed to co-operate with the Government of Puducherry in implementing the directions of the Government of India in the matter of admission of students to Post Graduate courses without fail.
