




The Mahe Institute of dental Sciences have submitted the merit list of the candidates applied for Dental Course. The total no. of seats available in the college is 100. The number of seats surrendered to Government comes to 35. For the 65 seats available in the Management, 80 numbers of applications have been received and 49 candidates alone have sought for admission and the balance of 16 seats are yet to be filled. The management stated that they are surrendering the same to the Government for filling up the seats.

Intimation was sent to Sri Venkateswaraa Dental College to send the list of candidates admitted to their institute. Till now we have not received the same, the Nodal Officer is directed to obtain the same and forward the same to the committee through email.


