**N O T I C E**

WHEREAS, a meeting of the Fee Committee, under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Justice S. Rajeswaran, High Court Judge (Retd.) was held on 14.09.2016 at 11.00 AM in his Chamber. The Chairman also met the representatives of the Parent Teacher Association who raised an objection, mainly for the excess fee collected by the Private Medical Colleges. The Chairman had directed all the Medical Colleges which comes under the purview of the FEE Committee to adhere strictly the following points in the matter of collecting fees:

- a) The Colleges should stop collecting the alleged excess fees from the students immediately.
  - b) The Colleges should collect only the fees already fixed by the earlier Committee, till the finalization of the fee structure for the present year by this Committee.
  - c) The Colleges may, if they want, obtain a written undertaking from the parents/students that the fee is being paid subject to final fixation of the fee by the Fee Committee
2. NOW THEREFORE, the Colleges may take note that any violation in the above direction will be viewed seriously.
3. Further, it is also informed to the Medical Colleges that the next meeting of the Committee is fixed on 27.09.2016 at 11 AM at PIPMATE Conference Hall, Lawspet, Puducherry. The Medical Colleges are at liberty to furnish / submit their grievances, if any, to the Committee on or before 23.09.2016 so as to consider the same in the next meeting.
